Philosophy.

Keyboard Kids Kindergarten Program is designed to provide an educationally sound curriculum for children who are five years of age by December 31st. Our staff is skilled in engaging children in innovative, unique and creative learning experiences. There are differences in the approach to teaching and learning, but our focus will always be to create an environment that helps children discover that learning is fun and meaningful.

Our most important goal is to help your child develop high self-esteem. We encourage children to feel good about who they are and what they accomplish. We foster a child's natural curiosity and love for learning in an organized and creative classroom setting. Keyboard Kids Kindergarten Program teaches children to communicate and represent their ideas and knowledge through verbal and written expression. We use computers daily to reinforce and expand on our themes, as well as foster critical thinking, creativity and independent learning.

Socialization is also an important element of Kindergarten and we emphasize cooperation and acceptance among all of our students. Our program aims to **teach independence** thus building selfconfidence.

Our students are continually involved in active, hands-on activities that best facilitate learning in young children. We place importance on all four aspects in the development of a child: intellectual, social, emotional and physical growth.

READING.. our program teaches reading through phonics, literature, stories and poems. Our daily use of computers smartly enhances the child's reading. Children will progress at their own level as they develop an understanding of words and their meanings.

WRITING.. reading and writing develop together as children gain experience with language and literature. Journal writing is a unique way of recording a child's early writing. Handwriting skills are practiced daily.

MATH.. children will be taught to understand numbers through comparing, counting, measuring, sorting and matching. These concepts are reinforced with hands-on materials known as manipulatives. Patterning, classifying and the use of puzzles give children a visual representation of math and problem solving.

COMPUTERS.. daily use of computers provide students with the unique opportunity for interactive learning. This fun experience encourages independent thinking and creativity by using dynamic software designed for learning and problem solving.

LANGUAGE ARTS.. children will be surrounded in a language rich classroom with books, printed material, charts and their own words recorded in journals.

SCIENCE.. the study of science unfolds as children investigate and ask questions about the world around them. They learn how animals live, how things work and about their own health. We examine the properties of nature and all living things.

SOCIAL STUDIES.. children explore the lives and cultures of families in our community and around the world. We learn about other cultures and places to gain an appreciation for those whose lives are different from ours.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION.. active play helps children learn the value of exercise. They build physical strength and muscular coordination by daily indoor and outdoor play. Creative movement is used to develop gross motor skills.

MUSIC.. singing, dancing, acting and playing musical instruments are fun and exciting ways for our students to express themselves and be creative.

ART self expression and creativity are integrated daily into the Kindergarten program. A multitude of materials are used to foster visual and tactile stimulation.
